ARCHIVE OF CANDIDATES IN THE FIELD OF INDUSTRIAL HYGIENE

The Department of Environmental Health of the School of Public Health of the University of Puerto Rico Medical Sciences Campus announces the opening of requests of information to compose the archives in the area of Industrial Hygiene, which may be used for future hiring of Faculty. Candidates should have experience in teaching, research, creative labor, and community service, as well as in developing proposals and publications. In addition, candidates should contribute to strengthening of institutional, occupational, and community service, and to participate actively in projects that forward the missions of the Industrial Hygiene Program, the Department of Environmental Health, the School of Public Health, the Medical Sciences Campus, and the University of Puerto Rico.

Candidates will have to comply with the Elements of Academic Performance established in sections 45.5 and 65 of "Reglamento General de la Universidad de Puerto Rico (RGUPR)", and what is defined in the applicable certifications issued by the Administrative Board of the Medical Sciences Campus, and Government Board of the UPR System.

It is expected that selected faculty engage in specialized and institutional assessment and accreditation processes, and will accept the requirements of a contractual letter, as established by the Department of Environmental Health.

WHO CAN QUALIFY: All candidates that comply with the minimum requirements of the position.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A doctoral degree in Industrial Hygiene, Industrial Engineering, Occupational Health and Safety, or in a related field.
- To be a citizen or a permanent resident of the United States of America.
- Excellent skills in oral and written communication in both English and Spanish.
- Develop and present graduate courses in Industrial Hygiene sampling, industrial ventilation, evaluation and control of physical and chemical risks, occupational toxicology, occupational health and safety, and ergonomics.
- Capacity to develop research programs, to write proposals, and to obtain external funds in the Industrial Hygiene field, occupational health and safety, and related research areas.
- To have either CSP or CIH, credentials.
- Actively participate in the development and implementation of study plans for the students admitted to the Industrial Hygiene Program, as well as in student recruitment activities.
- To be able to incorporate tutoring of students as part of faculty workload.
- To be able to integrate technology to daily education activities.

Note: Documented experience in academic and field work, will be considered separately or combined, as an advantage.

- Curriculum vitae
- Diplomas and grade certifications
- Credit transcripts
- Three recommendation letters (should include previous employers)
- Letter of Intent, summarizing the candidate's immediate and future plans as a faculty member, in research, and in the provision of services.


