




# White workers comprise the largest number, though workers of color are disproportionately impacted by workplace fatalities




Increase in mortality rates among working age adults in California

# Brainstorming: What kinds of activities are you thinking about doing?

- Human Impact Partners: Releasing report Walmart-lack of paid sick leave / partner with United for Respect; Seeking tweet/social media - Pressure Walmart;
- Strengthening Sanctuary Alliance - based in Olympia, WA, organizing for immigrant labor protections, particularly for undocumented folks. Strengthening sanctuaries in the capitol; putting pressure on local decision makers to increase access to COVID vaccine/testing/protections. Also working on labor hazards of wildfire smoke. Main goal is to be a voice for folks who are often not heard.
- Last year - did a series of blogs on worker advocacy, will be touching base about day-of advocacy
- Protecting Workers Alliance listserv - vibrant health and safety network

USW Int'l planning a virtual event on 4/28 with their IU president

Need a training for Ag workers in evening

NC AFL-CIO will hold either a virtual or safe in person service (presser + bell ringing); we're also highlighting our **comic book** episode about the right to a Safe Job: <http://bit.ly/ncaflcomic> and <http://bit.ly/ncaflcomica> (espanol)

Facebook/online ads to try to reach families who lost a loved one from work-related COVID infection. Similarly, outreach to religious groups/community groups.

Justice Center in North Carolina will support the National Event and is learning about these types events.

New Hampshire COSH will do an event that features OSHA turning 50. New England COSH groups will work together to amplify all efforts.

In Central New York, five groups come together to observe the day and create action. It will be virtual this year again. We will feature workers' stories..

Pittsburgh-Looking into what they are doing this year given the restrictions

WNYCOSH: Planning a safe, in person event at the local memorial in a park

SoCalCOSH: thinking about some type of inperson (car caravan?), as well as an online version

Border workers united: concentrating on education for undocumented and low income workers, and thinking about what might be possible to participate in

**During Workers' Memorial Week, we remember those who have lost their lives, been injured, or suffered illnesses at work, and to renew their fire to fight for safe workplaces.** During this time, unions, surviving family members, and health and safety activists nationwide around the world come together to take action. This is a week of action planned around Workers' Memorial Day, which is commemorated on April 28 each year.

**In many ways, this year is the biggest Workers' Memorial Week our movement has planned!** While all other workplace-related injuries, illnesses, and fatalities still persist, millions of people have contracted COVID at work, and the public's eyes are finally on occupational safety and health.




